NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

- 1) Balance Sheet The District started its new year with \$1,788,156 more in cash compared to last year.
- 2) Treasury Bills Change in market values from the prior month decreased by \$2,420. Interest paid into the Charles Swab sweep account was \$41,259. The five ladders of values carry an average rate of 4.89%
- 3) Wells Fargo Advisors CD are fully invested with values totaling \$2,655,000 composing of eleven certificate of deposits.
- 4) Revenue & Expense October 2024 only. Interest Income is up by \$26k. Sales Tax is down by \$104k. TIFMAS reimbursements totaled \$463K.
- 5) Checks over \$2,000 with explanations:
 - a. J4 Trailers \$15,366 is to house one of the UTV Apparatus at Station 302.
 - b. Braskey Products \$7,400 is for instructors' compensation for the ALL SAWS course at Station 301. Numerous ESD's from nearby ESD's are attending and are being invoice according to the number of firefighters attending.
 - c. Pinnacle Landscaping \$8,025 was for a one time fix to improve the battered looks in front of Station 301.
 - d. DreamSeats \$6,827 is to replace the seven highly used and crippled recliners at Station 301 that were purchased many years ago.

November 2024 Sales Tax Summary

The November allocation reflects sales made during the month of September.

Our November 2024 sales tax allocation was \$524,331 which was up 10.6% (+\$50,405) compared to November 2023 and down 4.7% (-\$48,069) year to date compared to last fiscal year.

Our top 10 large companies accounted for 53.3%, our top 30 large companies accounted for 68.9%, and our top 100 large companies accounted for 83.5% of our total fiscal year to date collections.

Increases this month compared to last year came from our largest lodging and construction companies as well as one of our landscaping companies. The new Discount Tire location continues to hold steady with strong performance. We saw a significant decrease (-44%) in the reporting for Vaughan & Sons and will be watching its performance in future months.







(Prior Fiscal Year + Current Fiscal Year-to-Date)



November 2024 Operations Report

Significant Events

October 9 (B) – Structure Fire – AutoAid Given (CE-Bar) – 1705 N Cuernavaca Drive [Truck 302] TK302 responded code 3 to a structure fire in ESD 10. While responding, units on scene reported detached shed on fire not structure. TK302 arrived on scene and while exiting the unit, command cleared all units except the first 2 on scene. TK302 cleared off the call and returned to service.

[BAT302] BAT302 responded to a structure fire. Upon arrival, there was an outside dry good storage shed that had caught fire and was under control when BAT302 arrived on scene. BAT302 met with BAT901 to do a quick face to face. BAT302 assisted BAT901 to investigate the fire and to make sure it was fully extinguished. It was recommended to call the Travis County Fire Marshal to determine the cause of the fire. BAT302 cleared the scene and returned to District.

October 16 (C) – Brush Fire (AutoAid Given – Austin) – 7400-7913 W US Highway 290 [Engine 301] E301 was dispatched to a small grass fire in the block range of 7400-7913 W Us 290 Hwy. While enroute, dispatch upgraded the incident to a brush alarm. The incident was located by E301 behind the Stetson Apartments at 7631 W Us 290 Hwy. E301 announced to all incoming units the updated address. Upon arrival, E301 LT performed a quick recon and located an approximately 60x60 fire involving a homeless encampment behind the apartment complex roughly 100 yards from E301. Incident Command was established by a BC from AFD. E301 LT requested a progressive lay supplied by E301 and one AFD crew to assisted with fire extinguishment. E301 established a water supply at a nearby hydrant in the complex with the assistance of E37. After fire extinguishment and mopup, several small trees were felled by BT301 due to safety concerns from fire involvement. All units returned to service.

October 18 (A) - Vehicle Rescue (AutoAid Received - Austin) - 9251 W SH 71 [Engine 301] E301 arrived to a two vehicle accident with a semi on top of a black EV6 with heavy damage. E37 on scene prior to our arrival and called a DOS on a single occupant in a black sedan. Semi had a single driver who was a no patient. E301 stayed on scene and extricated victim per BAT302. E301 stayed on scene until the highway was cleared. Then TCSO cleared E301 and we returned to service.

[TK302] TK302 was the last unit to arrive on scene and we blocked the intersection of Thomas Springs and 71. Then, TK302 took our tools up to the scene to assist with getting the driver out of the car. E37 and E301 were already working on removing the driver and TK302 iust assisted in any way we could. Once the driver was removed from the vehicle. TK302 then had SO take over our position of blocking the roadway and we cleared the call.

[BAT302] BAT302 responded to a vehicle rescue. Upon arrival, there was one vehicle versus an eighteen wheeler. E301 and E37 were on scene and E37 called an obvious on the person in the vehicle. We located the driver of the eighteen wheeler and the person didn't need any medical attention. E37 had a handline down and E301 began to disconnect the hybrid vehicle. While E301 worked on disconnecting the batteries on the vehicle, TK302 worked on extricating the person. After an extensive extrication, the crews were able to extricate the person and we handed the patient off to the medics. BAT302 cleared E37 and TK302 while BAT302 and E301 stayed on scene to assist TCSO and DPS. BAT302 cleared the scene shortly after and E301 stayed on scene to further assist.

October 29 (C) - Trash Fire - 8116 Thomas Springs Rd

[Engine 301] Engine and Brush Truck 301 responded to a trash fire on Circle Drive. The correct address was on Thomas Springs Road, near the intersection of Circle Drive. This was the location of a mobile food trailer. A tire that was part of a trailer holding a large smoker/BBQ grill was on fire. The fire was small and mostly confined to the tire and a piece of wood used as a wheel chock. The brush truck extinguished with the red line. The entire area was wetted down and very little overhaul was needed.

It was probable that ash underneath the fire box of the smoker contained embers which blew toward the tire area and started the fire. Both units cleared.
